Wood Carving and Home Economics: Unique Wood Creations was developed five years ago after I pledged Omega Psi Phi, Inc. At the time I was interested in a very unique symbolism of my fraternity that no other member possessed. So I decided, to take a jig saw and create the image I had in mind out of a piece of wood. The product stood out creating positive chatter within my circle of friends which spread out to the community allowing me to create a consumer relation business "Unique wood Creations." In this business I provide a quality product based upon 4 areas: 1) customer service where you can reach me via cellphone or email without automated service. 2) people over pennies allows me to create a three-foot shield and still offer affordable pricing for the item. 3) usage handcraft skill omitting the usage of computational effects where you still come out cheaper by paying for the labor. 4) upcaping the customer request for a product. My highest clients come from Greek organizations; however, from there a network of clients are diversified by those needing home or office furnishing like shelves, baby chairs, and other wood based needs. On average the salary in this business is roughly \$45,000.00 just on Greek demand; so creating those 50 wood pieces this past holiday represented a great time investment. The challenge in this business is building an ACCOUNTABLE team to assist in pushing the products of Unique Wood Creations and maintaining a strict schedule. Although I know I can complete a product in a day or two because I enjoy the craft, I set realistic time frames due to other demands such as father, career, husband, and service. In this business keeping in focus on spirituality, family, and working smart leads to success. Spiritual and a work smart focus means having the ability to conduct your business due to

the skill being a natural talent allowing you to work smart in a way that doesn't deplete your energy towards other personal demands. Lastly but most importantly, family focus assists me in advancing my family in a way that helps them understand they can be whatever they want to be and get whatever is needed to be a success whether financial of physical is needed. To any future or current businessman, if you keep the latter at heart you can be successful in your craft.
