Thus, the endowment was created to provide scholarship funding to undergraduate me mbers as well as highly qualified undergraduate students in the College of Engineering and the School of Architecture for generations to come.

Our goal is to provide a check for \$100,000 to Prairie View A&M University at the 2019 Homecoming game, which is also the 35th Anniversary of Epsilon Gamma lota, Inc.
